



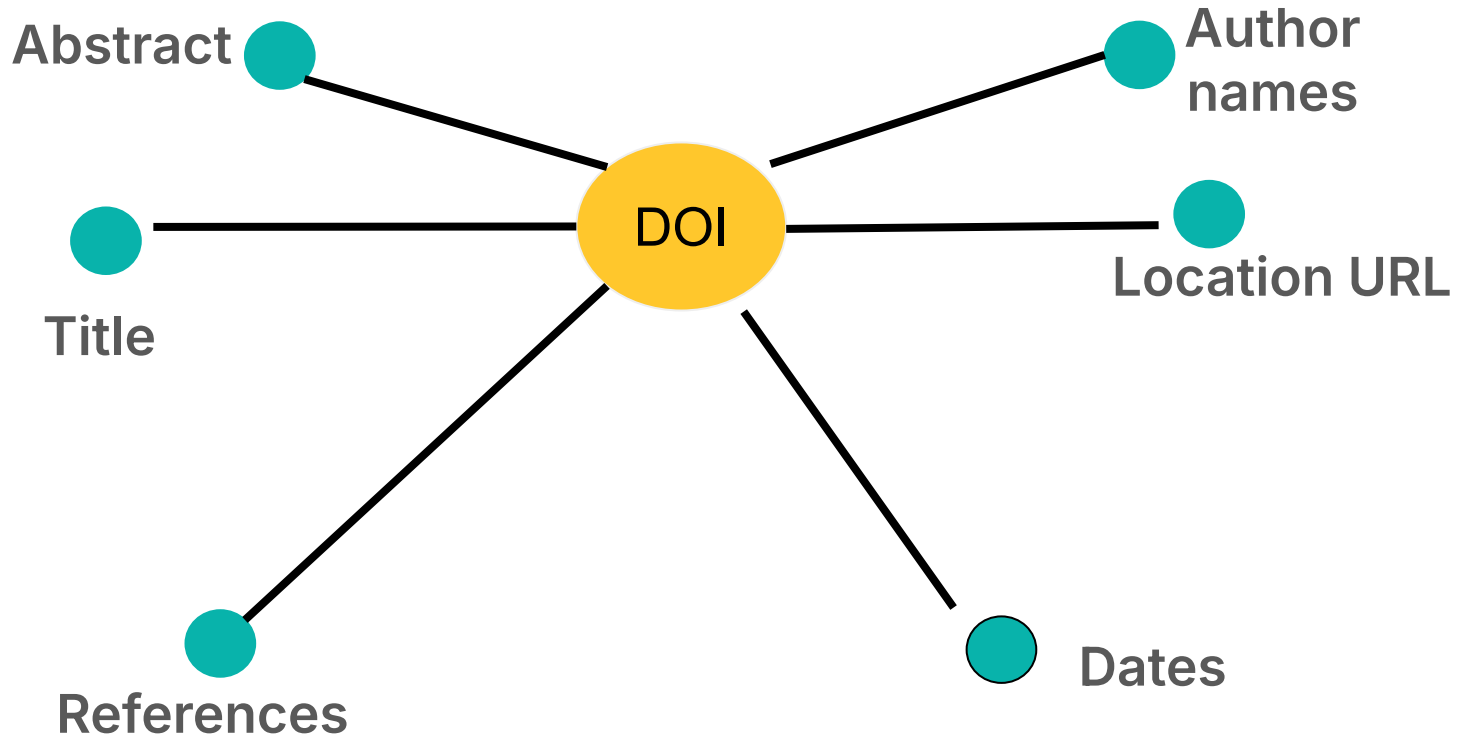
- Open, foundational scholarly infrastructure
 - Crossref assigns DOIs and collects metadata for grants, preprints, articles, chapters, proceedings, standards, reports, protocols, dissertations, reviews...and more
 - 160 million open metadata records with a DOI
 - ~20,000 members from 160 countries
 - 1.2 billion DOI resolutions every month

Services for our members:

- Reference linking
 - enables researchers to follow a link from the reference list to other publications, helping them to make connections and discover new things.
 - Similarity Check
 - Enables editors to assess the originality of the work before they publish it
 - Crossmark
 - The Crossmark button gives readers quick and easy access to the current status of an item of content, including any corrections, retractions, or updates to that record.
 - Crossref acquired and opened up Retraction Watch dataset
